#### Selection Criteria

The Executive Director, Program Director and a committee of community leaders will review the applications and interview candidates. The committee will strive to make each class reflective of our diverse community. The most important factor in the Leadership Kaua'i selection process is the identification of those individuals most apt to use their leadership for the long-term benefit of the community. The program selects individuals with a desire for a deeper understanding of Kaua'i and with a sincere commitment to serve in the community. The typical applicant will be a resident of Kaua'i and have demonstrated both an interest in community issues and have a record of participation/achievement in voluntary community activities.

### **Participant Time Commitment**

To accomplish the program's objectives, full participation of each individual is necessary. Participation includes **attendance of 5 classes.** The integrity of the program requires that participants be on time and present from start to finish (8 am to 2 pm) of each program day to both learn the leadership skills and to develop personal relationships.

This is the minimum certificate of completion requirement.

**Note on Attendance:** Sometimes it is difficult to attend a program for various reasons, including work and family responsibilities. Despite these challenges, each individual attendance is important for the entire class to function as a whole entity, as well as the integrity of the participant's leadership journey.
