Overview

VISION	“Educating and inspiring Kaua`i’s future leaders”
MISSION	To ensure a source of qualified and committed leaders on Kaua`i by engaging a cross section of individuals and developing their leadership skills to serve our community collaboratively.
BACKGROUND	Kaua`i has acknowledged the importance of good leadership, and major community sectors have stepped up and committed to identify, nurture and empower the individuals who will lead us into the future. Imagine a cadre of talented people, inspired and provided the tools to lead effectively. A diverse group of twenty adults and twenty high school students spend the best part of a year engaged in dynamic experiential learning designed to increase their potential to serve our community collaboratively. Leadership Kaua`i was created by a group of volunteers, modeled on successful leadership programs nationwide, and then customized for Kaua`i’s culture and needs.
ANNUAL LEADERSHIP PROGRAM (ADULT)	Leadership Kaua`i’s annual program joins a cross-section of 20 qualified Kaua`i individuals currently providing leadership in our community to further develop their leadership skills. During their time together participant teams learn and work together to resolve important community issues. Upon graduation, participants are challenged to use the skills and knowledge they gain for the long-term benefit of the community.
PI'INA HOKU YOUTH LEADERSHIP PROGRAM	Pi`ina Hoku (Stars that Rise) is Leadership Kaua`i’s youth leadership program. The first class began in August 2006. The program offers up to 20 High School students throughout Kaua`i an intensive leadership experience during their Junior year in high school. The program begins with a weekend retreat at Koke`e and continues with trainings one full day each month until a closing north shore retreat in March. Graduation is in April.
SPEAKER SERIES	When outstanding speakers are available, Leadership Kaua`i hosts speaker series events open to everyone providing an opportunity to hear excellent presentations in a pleasant collegial atmosphere while building leadership skills to address our island needs collectively.
